SUBJECT: PHYSICAL EVIDENCE

PHYSICAL EVIDENCE

- A. The Bureau maintains procedures for the seizure, safekeeping and disposition of all physical evidence that comes into its possession so as to document and ensure the security, integrity, chain of custody, and proper disposition.
- B. Physical evidence requiring laboratory analysis must be submitted to the laboratory in a timely manner.
- C. Physical evidence seized by field agents may not be stored in their vehicles or in their homes except for approved short durations of time.
- D. The Bureau conducts semiannual inspections of all physical evidence in the custody of SBI personnel.
